

Suite 140 is a highly customizable space featuring 25-foot ceilings, original exposed brick and large windows allowing for plenty of natural light. The suite has access to a shared conference room, bathroom and kitchen area. The entrance to the location fronts along Drayton Mill's iconic boardwalk, which overlooks the property's historic pond and connects to a walking and biking trail system.

This suite retains historic architectural features, but new tenants will still be able to customize the space by choosing paint colors. A loft space would be perfect for offices and overlooks the main floor.

## **ABOUT DRAYTON MILLS**



From luxury lofts to restaurants, corporate offices and a brewery, it's all at Drayton Mills. Completed in December 2015, Drayton Mills Lofts has become a thriving residential community, featuring a state-of-the-art fitness center, lap pool and bustling social spaces. These 289 luxury lofts — combined with nearly 60,000 square feet of commercial space at Drayton Mills Marketplace – represent the largest historic restoration project in South Carolina to date.

Drayton Mills is at the heart of a resurgence in the surrounding community. Conveniently located along Drayton Road and less than 3 miles from Morgan Square, Drayton Mills Marketplace is also fast becoming a destination for community events. Spartanburg School District 7 recently opened the new Drayton Mills Elementary School and the new Spartanburg High School.

## ABOUT THE COMMUNITY: SPARTANBURG

The 8<sup>th</sup> ranked small metro nationwide for millenial population growth, Spartanburg, SC recorded a 17.8 percent increase in the 25-34-year-old population during the past five years, according to Headlight Data. Part of that growth is fueled by a vibrant educational community that features seven colleges with a collective enrollment of 15,000 students.

Spartanburg County is a critical hub for commerce along the East Coast, with Interstates 85 and 26 intersecting here. In

2018 alone, the county recruited 20 economic development projects totaling more than \$779 million in capital investment and creating 2,094 jobs.

The county is also home to BMW's largest plant in the world, Milliken & Co.'s global headquarters and Denny's corporate headquarters, as well as the facilities of Toray Carbon Fibers, Michelin, Kobelco Construction Machinery, Rite Aid, adidas, Amazon and Keurig Green Mountain.
